



## FRENCH CONNECTION

The decidedly unglamorous Wynwood Arts District is an unlikely location for any trendy Parisian outposts, but it is exactly within this 20-block stretch that the Galerie Emmanuel Perrotin and new Galerie Bertin-Toublanc—sister galleries to Gallic counterparts of the same names—can be found. The emerging area bears no semblance to the City of Light, but the international rosters of artists—Bertin-Toublanc opened with works by India's Baba Anand, China's Lu Bolin and France's Supakitch—are worthy of their cosmopolitan birthplace. So's this: we hear Perrotin's planning a design collaboration with hip-hop's Pharrell Williams.
