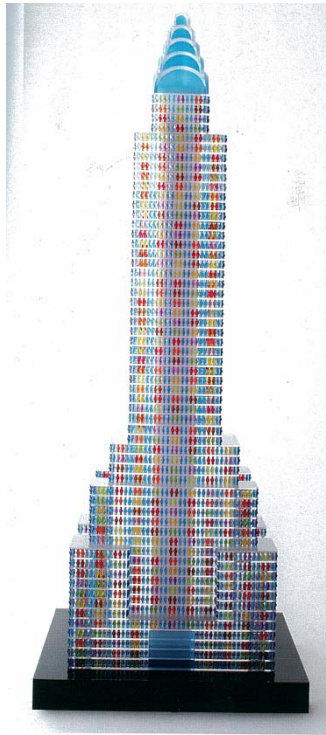




## WHAT'S HOT MIAMI BASEL

Miami's sizzling December Art Scene is painting the town red (and blue, yellow, green...) with wild parties and even wilder installations.

### WYNWOOD LA GALERIE BERTIN-TOUBLANC

Parisian gallerist Armelle Bertin-Toublanc establishes her first U.S. branch in a 17,000-square-foot duplex space including outdoor Zen garden in the Wynwood Art District. Bertin-Toublanc's first exhibition takes viewers on a global cultural odyssey, featuring five cutting-edge contemporary artists: India's Baba Anand, England's Mauro Perucchetti, France's Supakitch and Philippe Chevallier, and China's Liu Bolin. Her grand opening December 4 features themed parties for each exhibit characterizing the artists and their origins. For example, Anand's exhibit contrasts Bollywood and Hollywood, and India's deities versus Catholic saints. The centerpiece will be his grandest piece, a pink Cadillac with Swarovski crystals. In contrast, Supakitch, known for his neo-graffiti style inspired by the music of Daft Punk, will create his own personal universe within the new gallery's walls.
